- Opposed the Order of Canada for Dr. Henry Morgentaler in 2008
- Made public anti-choice or “pro-life” statements
- Participated publicly in anti-choice events or campaigns
- Rated as “pro-life” (green) by [Campaign Life Coalition](#)

*****Pro-choice MPs:** Estimate includes Conservative MPs with a public pro-choice position and/or pro-choice voting record. It also includes all Liberal MPs except the anti-choice or indeterminate ones, and all MPs from all other parties based on the assumption they are pro-choice or will vote pro-choice.

Update June 29, 2022: Liberal MP Francis Scarpaleggia (Lac-Saint-Louis, QC) has been removed from our anti-choice list after giving us assurances that he is pro-choice. Although he voted in favour of Bill C-484 in 2008, he would not vote again for a bill that might threaten abortion rights.

* Bernard Généreux voted Yes on Bill-225 but otherwise has a pro-choice record. We changed his listing after discussions with his office that satisfied our concerns.
